

MEMBERSHIP

There are four kinds of membership:

1) Active

- no more than one active member in each classification
- may propose new active members or additional active members with the approval of member holding classification
- may propose one new additional active in same classification

Additional Active

- member engaged in the same classification of an active member
- all the rights of an active member except he may not propose an additional active member

2) Senior Active

- the qualifications are:
- an active or past service member of one or more clubs for at least 15 years
- or a member of one or more clubs for at least 10 years and attains the age of 60
- or a member for at least 5 years and at least 65
- or a present or past Rotary International officer
- the member has all the rights of an active member, except
- he does not represent a classification and cannot propose an additional active member

3) Past Service

- the qualifications are:
- an active member whose active membership was terminated by retirement and
- a member in one or more clubs for at least 3 years
- or has attained the age of 55 years
- or loses his classification through no fault of his own may be elected by the board of directors
- the member has all the rights of an active member, except
- he does not represent a classification and cannot propose an additional active member
- Automatically becomes an active member if reenters active business if classification vacant, otherwise remains past service member

4) Honorary Member

- a person who has distinguished himself by meritorious service in the furtherance of Rotary ideals
- Membership automatically terminates on the 30th of June unless continued by the board of directors
- Exempt from payment of admission fees and dues
- Has no vote and not eligible to hold any office in this club
- Does not represent a classification
- May attend all meetings and enjoy all the other privileges of the club

ATTENDANCE

Requirements

Membership of any member other than an honorary member is automatically terminated if without the consent of the board, the member fails one of the following:

- 1) To attend or make-up four consecutive regular meetings
- 2) To attend or make-up at least 60% of the regular meetings in the first or second six months of the fiscal year
- 3) To attend at least 30% of the regular meetings of this club in the first or second six months of the fiscal year

Exemptions

A member's absence shall be excused and not computed in the club's attendance records if

- Protracted ill health or impairment or by a stay of more than two weeks in a country in which Rotary clubs do not exist

and notification in writing to the club secretary with Board approval

Or

- the member is senior active and
- a member of one or more clubs for at least 20 years and attained the age of 65
- or a member for at least 15 years and attained the age of 70

and notification in writing to the club secretary with Board approval

Or

- A leave of absence for a specified length of time may be granted upon written application to the board, setting forth good and sufficient cause
