The Almaden Valley Rotary Club completed another successful Community Service Project on the weekend of April 9, 10 and 11, 2010 at the South Valley Family YMCA in San Jose.

Approximately 35 volunteers from Almaden Valley Rotary Club, Oak Grove High School Interact Club and YMCA Board members and staff completed the project in record time with the guidance of Team Leaders. A barbeque lunch was also prepared and served by Rotarians and spouses to feed the volunteers.

The project consisted of four improvement areas: 1) flower plantings in the raised planter at the main entrance to the Y; 2) restoration of the children's play area with the installation of 15 yards of children's playground "firbar"; 3) replacement of picnic table tops/benches utilized by Y members/families for large outdoor Y events such as pancake breakfasts, post event celebrations, etc.; and 4) replanting of shrubs and ground covers where needed.
