December 8, 2006 Seniors Luncheon Notes

Almaden Valley Community Center ("AVCC")

1. For 2006, AVRC once again provided filet mignon steaks for the luncheon. The steaks were cooked medium rare to medium and were very tender for the Seniors. The steaks were well received as many favorable comments regarding the tenderness of the meat were received.
2. Ray Lester purchased charcoal, fuel and miscellaneous barbeque items.
AVRC to reimburse Ray \$32.00.
3. John Baker purchased the filet mignon steaks from Costco at a cost of \$932.72. In addition, \$19.98 was spent on sausages along with miscellaneous grocery purchases for garlic bread preparation in the amount of \$49.08.
AVRC to reimburse John in the amount of \$1,001.78. The filet was cut and trimmed into approximately 200 6 oz. steaks. We estimated 175 Seniors were fed, plus approximately 20 Rotarians, plus approximately 5 steaks eaten as "appetizers" during barbecuing
4. Paul Uenaka purchased four \$25 gift cards from Safeway and five 6" poinsettias from Tiedeman Nurseries for the Raffle. In addition, Tiedemann Nurseries donated 5 poinsettias for the Almaden Community Center luncheon and 5 for the South Valley Community Center luncheon. The Raffle was handled by Torie O'Reilly of AVCC. In addition, candy canes were passed out to each lunch attendee and the Simonds School Choir children. **AVRC to reimburse Paul in the amount of \$134.00.**
5. This year for the AVCC luncheon, AVRC was not required to reimburse the City of San Jose for such items as dessert, vegetables, butter, etc., as these items were already included in their budget for the December 8th luncheon.
6. Ms. Terry Bermudes of Simonds School was once again very cooperative regarding the children performing at the luncheon. They performed from 12:30 to 12:50 p.m. to the delight of the Seniors in attendance. They mentioned that they would be delighted to return again in 2007.
7. A donation of \$200.00 was made to Simonds Music & Technology Foundation and forwarded to Ms. Terry Bermudes with thanks by President Mel for the Simonds School Children Choir's performance.
