Several weeks before the party, an order was made with Di Puccio's for two pastas, white and marinara, sausage, salad and bread. They also provided plates and plasticware.

Several days before the party, a pickup was made at the Hasslers storage. Cups, paper towels, napkins, dessert plates, coolers, coffee pot, some soft drinks, some beer, tonic water, club soda, wine and a lot of booze were picked up.

The setup started at 5:00 pm by Jerry and Joyce Gibson. Four strands of lights were put up into the trees. The patio was swept and the chairs were cleaned off. The soft drinks, beer and wine were iced down. Table clothes and some decorations were put on the tables. And the booze was setup as a bar on the end of the counter. One of the heaters was lit and the fire pit was lit.

During dinner approximately half of the participants colored with crayons, a picture of Columbus and his ship. Many sat around the fire pit into the evening.
