REGISTRATION: - HP Arena - San Jose 9:00-10:00 a.m

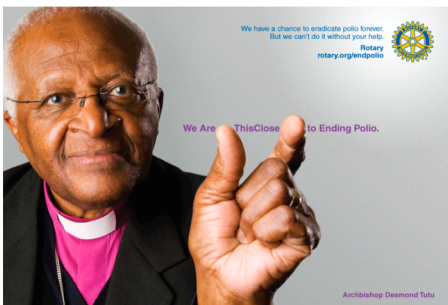
WALK: 10:00-11:00 a.m. **ROUTE:** HP Pavilion at San Jose, W. Santa Clara and Autumn Street to San Jose City Hall, E. Santa Clara Street and 4th Street - 1.2 miles

ENTRY FEE: \$25 includes a World Polio Day commemorative packet: T-shirt, lapel pin, wrist band and RI Pres. Ray Klinginsmith signed Certificate of Achievement. Those with commemorative packets do not need to register.
