New member information will be accomplished first through Rotary Information talks at the member's home, the red badge program which includes being the greeter at the noon meetings and an information booklet which outlines the history and accomplishments of the Almaden Valley Rotary club. Additionally, fireside chats are being used for new members after they have been in the club for six to twelve months to address questions in an informal setting.

The Almaden Valley Rotary club will continue to excel in all areas of Club Service:
